



## ISHLT LINKS ARTICLE POLICIES

### Article Format

- 1) Article length is typically 600-800 words, but there is no set length.
- 2) Creativity is of utmost importance! We're looking for great content, of course, but use your wit and wisdom to enhance your article and grab the reader's attention.
- 3) For articles with **only one author**, please provide an author photo and email address for inclusion in the article; **two or more authors** – email addresses only (no photos)

### Links Article Referencing

- List all authors when three or fewer; when four or more, list first three and add et al.
- Place all references at end of article.

#### Reference examples:

- **Journal article:** Salvatierra O, Vincenti F, Armend W, et al. Four-year experience with donor-specific blood transfusions. *Transplant Proc* 1983;15:924-6.
- **Books:** Eisen HN. *Immunology: an introduction to molecular and cellular principles of the immune response*. 5th ed. New York: Harper & Row; 1974. p. 406.
- **Chapters:** Fromer PL. Workshop on congestive heart failure. In: Braunwald E, Mock MB, editors. *Congestive heart failure*. New York: Grune & Stratton; 1982. p. 1-2.

### Disclosure Statement

Each article submission, regardless of its type, must include a financial conflict of interest disclosure statement. This statement should be included either 1) at the end of the article, or 2) AFTER the end of the article and BEFORE the references. The statement must also include any funding sources or acknowledgements of contribution of any material nature. The conflict of interest statement should describe ALL authors' relationships with companies or relevant entities that make products pertinent to the article. The statement should specify the type of relationships (e.g., consulting, paid speaking, grant support, equity, patents) EACH author has with EACH company. This item is of serious concern to the editorial office and no articles will be published if this data is not available.

The role(s) of the funding organization, if any, in the collection of data, its analysis and interpretation, and in the right to approve or disapprove publication of the finished article must be described in the section as indicated above.

#### Disclosure statement examples:

- The author(s) has no conflicts of interest to disclose.
- "Dr X" reports receiving consulting fees from "Device Company A" and "Device Company B".
- "Ms J" reports receiving consulting fees from "Pharma Company A" and "Device Company C". None of the other authors has a financial relationship with a commercial entity that has an interest in the subject of the submitted article or other conflicts of interest to disclose.
